### **WORSHIP AT ST. PAUL'S ANGLICAN**

ST. PAUL'S VISION STATEMENT—Rooted in the past yet relevant today: St Paul's **sows** the Good News of Jesus for all people, cultivates servant leaders, and grows neighborly communities.

Our worship is similar to that of Anglicans across the world and through the ages. We are a warm and loving congregation. We enjoy traditional hymns as well as modern worship songs produced by popular Christian artists. Worship that is biblical and draws hearts to the praise, honor, and glory of our Lord, is the goal at all of our services.

Our traditional worship with hymns is held in the historic Church Building. The contemporary worship, with a user-friendly screen and modern music, is in Doar Hall. We invite you to join us. All baptized Christians are welcome to join us for Holy Communion at the Lord's table.

**COMMUNION**—Anyone baptized in the Christian faith is welcome to receive communion.


